What's the difference between Change & Transition

- Change is the event, the snapshot
- Transition is the process, the journey that unfolds before, during, and after the change event

3 phases of transition: endings, neutral & new beginnings.

- 1. Transition Begins with an Ending
 - a. This is a season of letting go
- 2. The next phase is the Neutral or the Messy Middle
 - a. The neutral is a season of surrender
 - i. Surrender to the process
 - ii. Surrender and trust that I AM receiving clues about who I am becoming and what is next
- 3. Lastly, we have New Beginnings
 - a. New Beginnings is about alignment and integration

When we are aligned with deep longings, we become powerfully motivated.

Ways I can engage transition:

- 1. Rest
 - a. I have all I need
 - b. He's giving me good and perfect gifts, no matter what season I'm in
 - c. Just receive
- 2. Relationship
 - a. What is the Father saying? Tune in to the Holy Spirit.

b. Most of us need extra support in transition - mentors, coaches, small group, friends

3. Remember

- a. Stones of Remembrance
- b. Allow Him to build our faith in the middle of transition look back at old seasons of transition and remember His faithfulness, His good gifts
